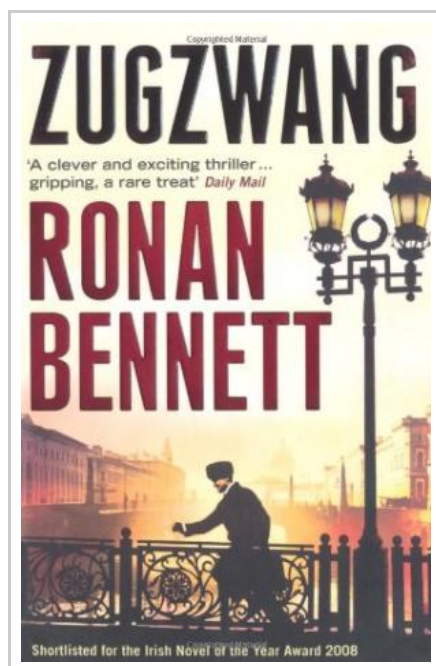




Zugzwang (New edition)
